#### **Additional Information**

**Description:** Unique bi-coloured variety with the fact the two colours run all the way through the petals to the very tip rather than just at the base like many others. This gives a lovely sky coloured effect as the blues fade into the centre of each petal, with each flower measuring up to around 15cm or 6". By far the most two-tone coloured Agapanthus we know of.

**Growing Information:** Plant your Agapanthus in well-drained soil, in a place that receives sun for most of the day. Plant 30cm apart in the ground or in pots. Feed weekly or fortnightly with a balanced liquid feed during the growing season until flowers begin to show colour. Keep plants moist until autumn, after the flowers start to fade, to encourage the development of new flower buds. Mulch in autumn or cover the crowns with straw or horticultural fleece to protect from frost.
