□ Tackle weeds now and your summer workload will be much reduced. Just take care where you step to avoid any bulbs brave enough to be poking their noses up.

Prune hybrid tea and shrub roses this month. They will flower on this season's stems so prune them hard, cutting just above a bud and removing all weak, damaged and crossing stems.

Lily bulbs planted now, in containers, will have plenty of time to grow in preparation for a magnificent display in summer.

 \Box Sow sweet peas – no summer garden is complete without them.

□ Pot up your over-wintered dahlia tubers to start them into growth.
