**Growing Information:** Growing your Veranda Red from seed  
-Tomato plants are extremely popular to grow from seed.  
Tomato seeds should be planted from late- January to April  
- Veranda Red seeds can be sown right through until the end of April. Sow in pots or in a propagator on a windowsill at approximately 18-21C (65-70F) using a good quality moist compost. Germination will occur within 7 - 14 days.

Transfer seedlings when large enough to handle into 11cm (4") pots and grow on to fruiting on the windowsill. alternatively, when the danger of frost has passed, you can plant in a window box or into 25cm (10") pots on the patio. Bush variety, no pinching or staking required.
